Summer 2024: June 15th - July 20th


Join the Leo Marchutz School of Painting & Drawing for a five-week interdisciplinary art program in France from June 15th through July 20th, 2024. Students will immerse themselves in the daily practice of painting and drawing in both the studio and the landscape of the south of France, and will participate in weekly discussion-based seminars, creative writing classes, and introductory French sessions. Additional complementary activities include day trips to surrounding areas (coastal towns along the Mediterranean Sea and the nearby sites of Cézanne and Van Gogh), and additional cultural and academic opportunities. This interdisciplinary program is designed to connect all activities into one collaborative process to help students see more into the world and into themselves. No prior experience in art or French is required; all courses are taught in English. Room and board, orientation, all intraprogram travel, student insurance, books, and art supplies are included in the program price. The program price does not include any airfare. Scholarships are available.
